2. Extension of Administrative Service Time

Date: Every 1st and 3rd Thu.

Time: 8:30 a.m. - 7:00 p.m.

Services and Sections:

Civil Registration Section: Resident registration, seal (hanko) registration, passport issuance, and publishing of other certifications and permissions, procedures of national health insurance and national pension plan and long life medical care for the elderly.

Elderly Welfare Section: Application of long-term care insurance and support of the elderly.

Tax Section: Issuance of certifications, (local) taxpayer assistance (needs reservation)

Accounting Section: Payment of tax (except national tax, prefectural tax and national pension premiums) and royalties.

Childcare Support Section: Procedures for day-care center, application of children allowance and child-rearing allowance.

Waterworks Section: Procedures to supply public water, payment of water and sewage bills.

3. Sister City Exchange Activities with Idaho Falls City in USA

Tokai Village made an international sister city agreement with the city of Idaho Falls U.S.A. in July, 1981. Since then, more than 1000 students and adults of Tokai Village and Idaho Falls City have been visiting each other's country over the last 37 years.

Mayor Yamada with other 8 members visited Idaho Falls City in October as Tokai Village Adult delegation and met Mrs. Rebecca Casper, Mayor of Idaho Falls.

They also visited council, Idaho National Laboratory, a facility for volunteers, a high school and a university, and had a lot of great opportunities to learn about the American culture and its traditions during their stay.

4. Garbage Disposal during New Year Holidays

-Garbage collection days and times for burnable garbage will change over the New Year period.

1) Collection day Monday and Thursday area:

The last collection; Mon. 31 Dec. 2018

The first collection; Mon. 7 Jan. 2019

2) Collection day Tuesday and Friday area:

The last collection; Fri. 28 Dec. 2018

The first collection; Fri. 4 Jan. 2019

*Be sure to take burnable garbage in the designated bag to the collection site by 8:30 a.m..

If you take your garbage directly to both of the clean centers in Tokai and Hitachinaka; The last day when garbage can be carried in directly to the clean centers is Sat. 29 Dec. 2018. The first day is Fri. 4 Jan. 2019.

As this period is usually very crowded, it is recommended to come earlier. The garbage available to be taken directly to the clean center is as following and neither center will accept garbage in any category other than these:

Hitachinaka • Tokai Clean Center; burnable garbage

*Open from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. only on Sat. 29 Dec..

Tokai Clean Center; unburnable garbage, bulky rubbish, recyclable waste, pruned branches and leaves

*Open from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. (except noon - 1:00 p.m.) only on Sat. 29 Dec..
