2. Extension of Administrative Service Time

Services and Sections:

Civil Registration Section; Resident registration, seal (hanko) registration, My Number Card, passport issuance, and publishing of other certifications and permissions

Health Insurance Section; Procedures of National Health Insurance, National Pension Plan, Long Life Medical Care for the Elderly, Medical Welfare Subsidy and Long-term Care Insurance

Tax Section; Issuance of certifications, (local) taxpayer assistance (needs reservation)

Accounting Section; Payment of tax (except national tax, prefectural tax and national pension premiums) and royalties

3. Special Child Allowance

The village will provide Special Child Allowance (10,000 yen per child) to all households with children under 18 years old as of Apr. 1. (No income limit)

The allowance will be transferred to the bank account of eligible households on 31 Jan. Application forms are not required. However, those under certain conditions need to apply for the allowance. For details, contact the Allowance Payment Office by Tue. 28 Feb.

7. Emergency Support Benefits for Price Hikes for Lower Income Households

The Japanese government provides a Special Relief Payment (50,000 yen) to lower income households (once per household). Confirmation letters have been sent in Nov. to Resident Tax-Exempt Households. Households that experienced a sudden decrease in income after Jan. 2022 may be eligible for the payment. To confirm, contact the Community Welfare Section.
