4. Subsidy for Day Care Fees for Households with Multiple Children

Eligible people:

A child of a household who meets all the conditions below;

- 1) The child is a resident of Tokai village as of 1 Feb. 2024, aged between 0 and 2 years, and attending a daycare.
- 2) The household has more than two children and the child is not the first child.
- 3) The child is not eligible for free daycare service.

Subsidy: 3 months of daycare fees for eligible children (from Jan. to Mar. 2024)

Application: Application forms will be distributed to eligible people by daycare facilities. Fill in and return the form by Thu. 29 Feb.

5. Ibaraki Prefectural Mutual Aid Traffic Accident Insurance

The insurance provides compensation in case of a traffic accident.

Annual mutual aid premiums:

900 yen per person

500 yen per person for junior high school students and under

Eligible traffic accidents:

-Accidents while driving/riding a car, a motorcycle or a bicycle

-A collision with a car, a motorcycle or a bicycle while walking

The plan covers accidents only in Japan.

Mutual aid period:

Coverage is from 1 Apr. to 31 Mar. Coverage begins the day after payment.

How to claim:

Bring the following documents to the Environmental Policy Section.

-Member's card, Driver's license, Traffic accident certificate, Medical certificate

Compensation for traffic accidents:

Class 1: Death---1,000,000 yen

Class 2: An injury that had more than 181 treatment days---300,000 yen

Class 3: An injury that had more than 151 treatment days---250,000 yen

Class 4: An injury that had more than 121 treatment days---200,000 yen

Class 5: An injury that had more than 91 treatment days---150,000 yen

Class 6: An injury that had more than 61 treatment days---100,000 yen

Class 7: An injury that had more than 41 treatment days---80,000 yen

Class 8: An injury that had more than 21 treatment days---60,000 yen

Class 9: An injury that had more than 8 treatment days---30,000 yen

Class 10: An injury that had more than 3 treatment days---20,000 yen

Physical Disability: Disability grade 1 or 2---500,000 yen
