3. Countermeasures Against the Coronavirus

(1) Exemption of water supply charges for Jun. and Jul.

Households and businesses using water supply in the village as of 15 Jul. will be exempt from the water supply charges for Jun. and Jul. Sewage charges will not be exempted. Application is not required.

(2) Special Relief Payment for Lower Income Households

The Japanese government has been providing a Special Relief Payment (100,000 yen) to lower income households. Eligible households have already been provided with the payment in the last fiscal year.

However, if your household becomes eligible this fiscal year for the first time, you will receive a Verification Form in Jul. Fill in the form and return it in the enclosed envelope to Community Welfare Section to receive the payment.

If you do not receive a Verification Form but your household has experienced a sudden decrease in income due to the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic, you may be eligible for the payment. To confirm, contact the Community Welfare Section.

(3) Special Child Allowance for Lower Income Households

Special Child Allowance (50,000 yen per child) will be provided to lower income households with children under 18 years old.

The allowance will be transferred to the bank account of eligible households in Jun. or Jul. Application forms are not required. However, those under certain conditions need to apply for the allowance. For details, contact the Childcare Support Section.

4. Registration for My Number Point Campaign 2 from 30 Jun.

My Number Card is an IC-chip embedded plastic card that shows your name, address, date of birth, sex, your 12-digit My Number (individual number), along with your photo. It can be used as an official ID card. Starting 30 Jun., you can earn My Number Points by issuing your My Number Card and registering it for the following purposes.

- -Application deadline for issuing My Number Card: 31 Sep. 2022
- -Application deadline for My Number Point: 28 Feb. 2023

(1) If you apply for issuing your My Number Card for the first time and register a cashless

payment service, you are eligible to receive up to 5,000 yen worth of points for your usage

of the registered cashless payment service.

(2) If you register your My Number Card as a health insurance card and apply for My Number

Point, you will receive up to 7,500 yen worth of points.

(3) If you register your bank account for receiving benefits from the government and apply

for My Number Point, you will receive up to 7,500 yen worth of points.
