3. Coronavirus Vaccination Information

Vaccination for Children aged 6 months to 4 years

Children between 6 months old and 4 years old are now eligible for Coronavirus Vaccination free of charge. Vaccination Coupons will be sent to eligible people. Appointments can be made once you receive the vaccination coupon.

Children between 6 months old and 4 years old will receive three jabs of Pfizer vaccine designed for children with a period of 3 weeks after a first dose and with a period of 8 weeks

after a second dose. The influenza vaccine and the Covid vaccine can be received at the same time. No other vaccinations can be given for two weeks before and after the Covid vaccinations.

Vaccination for children is not an obligation. Please understand the effects and side effects before deciding for your children to be vaccinated.

4. Emergency Support Benefits for the Price Hike for Lower Income Households

The Japanese government will provide a Special Relief Payment (50,000 yen) to lower income households (once per household).

Confirmation letters will be sent to Resident Tax-Exempt Households in Nov.

Households that experienced a sudden decrease in income after Jan. 2022 may be eligible for the payment. To confirm, contact the Community Welfare Section.
