- 7. Parents/guardians are studying at any school or in job training.
- 8. Parents/guardians are abusive.

Capacity: A few places are available at each of the daycare centers.

\*Availability will differ depending on the age of infant or toddler and the institution.

**Application**: Submit the application form (available at Childcare Support Section or can be downloaded from Childcare Support portal website "Nobi-nobi Kosodate Cho") and documentary proof of why care at home is not possible (e.g. certificates of employment or medical certificates) to Childcare Support Section on the 4th floor of Tokai Village Office between Mon. 13 and Fri. 24 Nov. from 8:30 a.m. to 5:15 p.m. (except weekends and public holidays). From 8:30 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. only on Thu. 16 Nov.
