2. Extension of Administrative Service Time

Date: Every 1st and 3rd Thu.

Time: 8:30 a.m. - 7:00 p.m.

Services and Sections:

Civil Registration Section; Resident registration, seal (hanko) registration, My Number Card, passport issuance, and publishing of other certifications and permissions

Health Insurance Section; Procedures of National Health Insurance, National Pension Plan, Long Life Medical Care for the Elderly, Medical Welfare Subsidy and Long-term Care Insurance

Tax Section; Issuance of certifications, (local) taxpayer assistance (needs reservation)

Accounting Section; Payment of tax (except national tax, prefectural tax and national pension premiums) and royalties

Childcare Support Section; Procedures for day-care centers and kindergartens, application of child allowance and child-rearing allowance

Waterworks Section; Procedures to supply public water, payment of water and sewage bills

3. Home-childcare Allowance

Tokai Village will provide a Home-childcare Allowance for a household with more than two children that takes care of a child/children under three years old at home.

Eligible people:

Those who meet all of the following conditions:

- A registered resident of Tokai Village and living in the village
- Raising an eligible child in the same household at home
- Not receiving public assistance

Eligible children:

Those who meet all of the following conditions:

- More than 2 months old and less than 3 years old
- A registered resident of the village and living in the village
- Not enrolled in a daycare center or childcare facility
- Not the first child among your children. (Your first child is counted as a "first child" living in the same household until the following 31 Mar. after his/her 22nd birthday.)

Amount of payment: 10,000 yen per month per eligible child

Application: Submit the application form to the Childcare Support Section. For details, contact the Childcare Support Section.

5. Free Dental Checkups for Adults and Pregnant Women

Free dental checkups are available to adults of specific ages and pregnant women at the designated dental clinics.

Term: Until Mon. 31 Mar. 2025

Eligible people: Residents who will turn 30, 40, 50, 60 and 70 years old in fiscal 2024, and pregnant women

Cost: Free *Fees may be charged for additional treatments and cleanings.

Other: Vouchers will be sent to eligible people. Pregnant women will receive a voucher when the Maternal and Child Health Handbook (Boshi Kenko Techo) is issued. Contact Tokai Health Center if you recently moved to Tokai Village and don't have a voucher.

Talk about babies' crying / how to bathe a newborn / pregnancy experience for fathers / useful services for before and after childbirth. Bring an apron for each attendee. No childcare service will be provided.
