5. Treatment of Injuries Caused by Third Party's Acts

If you get injured by a third party's act, such as a traffic accident caused by another party, being bitten by someone's dog and food poisoning caused by food provided at a restaurant, the medical expenses for treatment shall be covered by the perpetrator as long as you are without fault.

In those cases, you need to contact Health Insurance Section before seeing a doctor. If you submit a registration form with the necessary documents to the village office, you may be able to use your insurance card or Marufuku/Marutoku certificate to pay for your medical expenses. Then later, the village applies for a refund from the perpetrator.
