Rice fields throughout Tokai Village will be sprayed with insecticide by unmanned helicopters for insect pest control. We appreciate your understanding and cooperation.

Sat. 26 Jul., 4:30 a.m. – 11:00 a.m. (In case it is postponed due to bad weather, the notification will be given through the community radio system.)

Area: All rice fields in the village

Type of insecticide: Amistar Trebon SE

Notes:

*Do not enter or approach the spraying area during spraying.

*Rice fields near main roads, school routes and residential areas will be sprayed early in the morning.

*If insecticide gets on your skin by any chance, wash it away with soap immediately.

*If insecticide sticks on your car, wash it away with water immediately as it could stain.

*Follow the instructions of the field workers to avoid accidents.
