2. Extension of Administrative Service Time

Date: Every 1st and 3rd Thu.

Time: 8:30 a.m. - 7:00 p.m.

Services and Sections:

Civil Registration Section; Resident registration, seal (hanko) registration, My Number Card, passport issuance, and publishing of other certifications and permissions

Health Insurance Section; Procedures of National Health Insurance, National Pension Plan, Long Life Medical Care for the Elderly, Medical Welfare Subsidy and Long-term Care Insurance

Tax Section; Issuance of certifications, (local) taxpayer assistance (needs reservation)

Accounting Section; Payment of tax (except national tax, prefectural tax and national pension premiums) and royalties

Childcare Support Section; Procedures for day-care centers and kindergartens, application of child allowance and child-rearing allowance

Waterworks Section; Procedures to supply public water, payment of water and sewage bills

3. 2024 Municipal/Prefectural Residence Tax (Individual) Notice

Residence tax is levied on all residents including foreigners who have resident registration in Tokai Village as of 1 Jan. The tax is calculated based on the income earned from January through December of the previous year, so it is imposed even if there is no income this year.

The tax notice will be mailed from Mon. 10 Jun. Please contact the Tax Section if you have not received the tax notice by Fri. 21 Jun. Employees whose taxes are deducted from their paychecks will receive the tax notice from their employers.

Payment: If you want to use direct debit to pay tax, please bring the necessary documents.

-Application at financial institutions

1) Bankbook, 2) Registered seal (hanko), 3) The tax notice

-Application at Tax Section (1F of Tokai Village Office)

1) Cash card (PIN number required), 2) Identity verification document

*If you want to pay with direct debit from the first term, apply at the Tax Section by Thu. 20 Jun. Payment by credit card will not be accepted.

*Tax can also be paid online (PayPay, LINE Pay, PayB or eL-QR).

2024 Special Tax Deduction

The Japanese government will provide special income/residence tax deductions in FY2024. The deduction will be 30,000 yen for income tax and 10,000 yen for residence tax per person. For details, see:
