Eligible People: Children who meet one of the following conditions, and have no family members residing in the household who can take care of them;

1. Parents/guardians work more than 64 hours a month.
2. The mother is about to give birth or has just recently given birth.
3. Parents/guardians are ill or have disabilities.
4. Parents/guardians have long-term nursing care obligations.
5. Parents/guardians are working in disaster recovery.
6. Parents/guardians are job-hunting or in the process of starting a business.
7. Parents/guardians are studying at any school or in job training.
8. Parents/guardians are abusive.

Capacity: A few places are available at each of the daycare centers.

*Availability will differ depending on the age of infant or toddler and the institution.

Application: Submit the application form (available at Childcare Support Section or can be downloaded from Childcare Support portal website "Nobi-nobi Kosodate Cho") and documentary proof of why care at home is not possible (e.g. certificates of employment or medical certificates) to Childcare Support Section on the 4th floor of Tokai Village Office between Mon. 11 and Fri. 22 Nov. from 8:30 a.m. to 5:15 p.m. (except weekends and public holidays). From 8:30 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. only on Thu. 21 Nov.

5. Tokai Village After-school Children's Club Application for 2025

(1) After-school Children's Club at each school

Open: After school until 7:00 p.m. Mon. through Fri. (except public holidays and New Year holidays). Special hours will be from 7:30 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. during extended and school holidays.

Place: Tokai Village After-school Children's Club (Ishigami, Funaishikawa, Nakamaru, Shirakata and Terunuma) *The club is located next to each elementary school.

Eligible People: Children who meet the following conditions:

- Children who will be in 1st to 6th grade of Tokai Village elementary school on 1 Apr. 2025.
- Children with working/sick parents, or parents with nursing care obligations, and have nobody at home who can take care of them after school.

Capacity: Around 25 children for Ishigami, Funaishikawa and Nakamaru, around 15 children for and Terunuma, around 10 children for Shirakata

*Children with higher necessities for childcare will be given priority.
