2. Extension of Administrative Service Time

Date: Every 1st and 3rd Thu. **Time:** 8:30 a.m. - 7:00 p.m.

Services and Sections:

Civil Registration Section; Resident registration, seal (hanko) registration, passport issuance, and publishing of other certifications and permissions, procedures of national health insurance and national pension plan and long life medical care for the elderly.

Elderly Welfare Section; Application of long-term care insurance and support of the elderly. **Tax Section**; Issuance of certifications, (local) taxpayer assistance (needs reservation)

Accounting Section; Payment of tax (except national tax, prefectural tax and national pension premiums) and royalties.

Childcare Support Section; Procedures for day-care center, application of children allowance and child-rearing allowance.

Waterworks Section; Procedures to supply public water, payment of water and sewage bills.

3. Public Transportation in the Village

(1) Public bus - MaaS Project

Mobility-as-a-Service (MaaS) is a type of service that through a joint digital channel enables users to plan, book, and pay for multiple types of mobility services.

"Hitachi Area MaaS Demonstration Experiment Project" started in 2020, which covers Takahagi, Hitachi, Tokai and Hitachinaka area. The project will continue until Mar. 2021.

In Tokai Village, the services include 600-yen One-day Open Bus Ticket and 10% discount of bus fare. You need to install Hitachi MaaS App to use these services.

(2) On-demand share-ride taxi service "Ainori-kun"

Ainori-kun is a service for Tokai Village residents, which provides door-to-door service (from your home or designated location to the destination), at lower fares compared with general commercial taxi service.

Conditions:

- -The service is available from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. (4:00 p.m. on Sat.) except Sun., public holidays and New Year holidays.
- -Both the departure point and the destination must be within Tokai Village.
- -The fare is 300 yen for one trip (one way), and 100 yen for disabled people, people certified for Long-Term Care and children under 5 years old.

How to use:

- 1. Apply for registration at any of the following places.
- -Tokai village Office; Welfare General Affairs Section or Eldery Welfare Section (1st floor)/ Planning and Management Section (3rd floor)
- -Tokai Village Social Welfare Council in Tokai Welfare Center "Kizuna"
- -Tokai Comprehensive Support Center "Nagomi"
- 2. Call "Ainori-kun" Reservation Center, ph. 029-306-2828 for reservation between two days before and 30 minutes before the time you want to use a taxi. You need to reserve a week in advance if you use a wheelchair.
