2. Extension of Administrative Service Time

Date: Every 1st and 3rd Thu. **Time:** 8:30 a.m. - 7:00 p.m.

Services and Sections:

Civil Registration Section; Resident registration, seal (hanko) registration, passport issuance, and publishing of other certifications and permissions, procedures of national health insurance and national pension plan and long life medical care for the elderly.

Elderly Welfare Section; Application of long-term care insurance and support of the elderly.

Tax Section; Issuance of certifications, (local) taxpayer assistance (needs reservation)

Accounting Section; Payment of tax (except national tax, prefectural tax and national pension premiums) and royalties.

Childcare Support Section; Procedures for day-care center, application of children allowance and child-rearing allowance.

Waterworks Section; Procedures to supply public water, payment of water and sewage bills.

3. Please Respond to the Census 2020

The national census by the Japanese government will be held from 14 Sep. to 7 Oct. 2020. The Census is the most important statistical survey and is held once every five years. It covers everyone that has lived or plans to live in Japan for more than three months, regardless of nationality. Everyone that is covered is legally obliged to respond, so please be sure to do so. Your responses will only be used to create statistics. Under no circumstances will official Census Takers ask for money or inquire about your income.

We appreciate your understanding and cooperation.

Schedule & how to respond:

(1) Distribution of Census Survey Documents (Mon. 14 to Wed. 30 Sep.)

A Census Taker will visit your household and distribute the Census survey documents by putting them into your mailbox.

*In principle, Census Takers will not meet you in person to prevent the spread of infectious diseases.

(2) Response Period (Mon. 14 Sep. to Wed. 7 Oct.)

Choose one of the following ways to respond.

A. Online (Mon. 14 Sep. to Wed. 7 Oct.)

Online response is recommended as it is quick and easy and can also avoid face-to-face contact.

Go to "Response Site" https://www.e-kokusei.go.jp/html/portal/en/top.html and follow the instructions on the screen to respond to the Census. Login ID and access key are provided in your survey documents.

*Online responses are available in the following languages; Japanese, English, Chinese (Simplified, Traditional), Korean, Vietnamese, Spanish and Portuguese. If you want to reply in another language besides the above, please contact General Affairs Section of Tokai Village Office. We will provide you the survey form of your choice.

*If you are not sure about the procedures, bring your survey documents and we will help you with the online response on the following dates.

B. By post (Thu. 1 to Wed. 7 Oct.)

Fill in the survey form and submit by mail in the enclosed envelope (no stamp needed).

C. Submission to Census Taker (Thu. 1 to Wed. 7 Oct.)

Fill in the survey form and submit it to the Census Taker.

(3) Request for Submission (from Thu. 8 Oct.)

If your response is not confirmed by Wed. 7 Oct., the Census Taker will ask for your responses.

7. Suspension of Lending Disaster Prevention Administrative Radios

Contents:

Suspension of new lending of disaster prevention administrative radios and replacement of a radio receiver due to breakdown.
