2. Extension of Administrative Service Time

Date: Every 1st and 3rd Thu. **Time:** 8:30 a.m. - 7:00 p.m.

Services and Sections:

Civil Registration Section; Resident registration, seal (hanko) registration, passport issuance, and publishing of other certifications and permissions, procedures of national health insurance and national pension plan and long life medical care for the elderly.

Elderly Welfare Section; Application of long-term care insurance and support of the elderly.

Tax Section; Issuance of certifications, (local) taxpayer assistance (needs reservation)

Accounting Section; Payment of tax (except national tax, prefectural tax and national pension premiums) and royalties.

Childcare Support Section; Procedures for day-care center, application of children allowance and child-rearing allowance.

Waterworks Section; Procedures to supply public water, payment of water and sewage bills.

3. Coronavirus Vaccination Information

Coronavirus vaccination will be provided free of charge to all residents in Japan generally at your place of resident registration. Please check the latest information from the village in the newsletters and on the Tokai Village Coronavirus Vaccination Website. Thank you for your understanding.

For people aged between 65 and 74

Vaccination Coupons will be sent to people aged between 65 and 74 on Tue. 8 Jun. Reservations will start from 9:00 a.m. on Wed. 16 Jun.

How to make a reservation

Vaccines will be administered individually at the designated medical institutions only by appointment. Have the coupon ready at hand and make a reservation for the first dose in one of the following three ways.

*You will make a reservation for the second dose at the venue where you receive the first dose. The second dose should be scheduled just three weeks after the first dose as a rule.

(3) Reservation Application Form

If you don't need to book immediately, you can also make a reservation by submitting the application form (coupon number required) by fax or in person. The application form is available at Tokai Village Coronavirus Vaccination Website, Tokai Health Center or Tokai Village Office reception desk. You cannot specify a preferred date or time. The assigned date and time will be notified within 10 days after application. We will accept your requests for medical institutions, but we may not be able to provide you with the medical institution of your choice.

In case of cancellation

Up to the day before: Cancel via Tokai Village Coronavirus Vaccination Website or Call Center. On the day: Contact the medical institution where you are scheduled to receive vaccination.

Priority coupon delivery for people aged between 16 and 64 with underlying medical conditions

Vaccination coupons will be sent to the above people in early July upon prior application. Please apply if you would like to be given priority for the vaccine.

Application period: Fri. 11 to Fri. 25 Jun.

What are underlying medical conditions?

People with underlying medical conditions are defined as those who meet any of the following criteria (as determined by the government as of 18 Mar. 2021).

- (A) People with the following illnesses or conditions who receive outpatient or inpatient care
- 1. Chronic respiratory disease
- 2. Chronic heart disease (including hypertension)
- 3. Chronic kidney disease
- 4. Chronic liver disease (liver cirrhosis, etc.)
- 5. Diabetes being treated with insulin or medication, or diabetes associated with other diseases
- 6. Blood diseases (excluding iron deficiency anemia)
- 7. Diseases that impair the functioning of the immune system (including malignant tumors under treatment)
- 8. Receiving treatment that depresses the immune system, including steroids
- 9. Neurological and neuromuscular diseases associated with immune abnormalities
- 10. Decreased body functions due to neurological or neuromuscular diseases (including breathing disorders)
- 11. Chromosomal abnormality
- 12. Severe mental and physical disabilities (severe physical disabilities and severe intellectual disabilities)
- 13. Sleep apnea syndrome

- 14. Severe mental illness (hospitalized for treatment of mental illness, holding a mental disability certificate or falling under the category of "severe and continuous" in self-supporting medical care (psychiatric hospital care)) or intellectual disabilities (holding a rehabilitation certificate)
- (B) Obese individuals who meet the criteria (BMI of 30 or higher)

BMI = Body weight (kg) \div height (m) \div height (m)

*Guideline for BMI of 30: height of 170cm and weight of 87kg, height of 160cm and weight of 77kg

4. 2021 Municipal/Prefectural Residence Tax (Individual) Notice

Residence tax is calculated based on a person's income in the previous year, and is levied on all residents including foreigners who have completed resident registration in Tokai Village as of 1 Jan.

The tax is calculated based on the amount of income earned from January through

December of the previous year, so it is imposed even if there is no income in this year.

The tax notice will be mailed from Fri. 11 Jun. Anyone who has not received the tax notice by Mon. 21 Jun., please inquire at the Tax Section.

Payment: If you want to use direct debit to pay tax, please bring the necessary documents.

- -Application at financial institutions
- 1) Bankbook or cash card
- 2) Registered seal (hanko)
- 3) The tax notice
- -Application at Tax Section (1F of Tokai Village Office)
- 1) Cash card (PIN number required)
- 2) Identity verification documents
- *If you want to pay the tax from the first term, apply at Tax Section by Mon. 21 Jun.

Payment made with credit card will not be accepted.

*Tax can also be paid online (PayPay, LINE Pay, PayB).
