## **Services and Sections:**

**Civil Registration Section;** Resident registration, seal (hanko) registration, passport issuance, and publishing of other certifications and permissions, procedures of national health insurance and national pension plan and long life medical care for the elderly.

**Elderly Welfare Section;** Application of long-term care insurance and support of the elderly. **Tax Section;** Issuance of certifications, (local) taxpayer assistance (needs reservation)

**Accounting Section;** Payment of tax (except national tax, prefectural tax and national pension premiums) and royalties.

**Childcare Support Section;** Procedures for day-care center, application of children allowance and child-rearing allowance.

Waterworks Section; Procedures to supply public water, payment of water and sewage bills.

## 3. Coronavirus Vaccination Information

The Japanese government has started administering third doses of coronavirus vaccine. Please check the latest information from the village in the newsletters and on the Tokai Village Coronavirus Vaccination Website.

## Vaccine for boosters

Either Pfizer or Moderna vaccine will be used for booster shots regardless of the type of vaccine given in the first two doses. You can choose which one you receive when you make an appointment, but this option may not be available depending on the distribution status of the vaccines.

## Eligible people for a booster shot

People aged 18 or older who took the second shot at least eight months ago. You will receive Vaccination Coupon when you are eligible for a booster shot.

#### How to make a reservation

Vaccines will be administered individually at the designated medical institutions only by appointment. Have the coupon ready at hand and make a reservation in one of the following three ways.

# (3) Reservation Application Form

If you don't need to book immediately, you can also make a reservation by submitting the application form (coupon number required) by fax or in person. The application form is available at Tokai Village Coronavirus Vaccination Website, Tokai Health Center or Tokai Village Office reception desk. You cannot specify a preferred date or time. The assigned date and time will be notified later. We will accept your requests for medical institutions, but we may not be able to provide you with the medical institution of your choice.

## What to bring on the appointment day

-Vaccination Coupon and the enclosed documents

-Your ID (My Number Card, insurance card, driver's license, etc.)

-Okusuri Techo (prescription record) if you are taking medication

\*If you have fever or feel unwell on the day, contact the medical institution to cancel your appointment.

### Exceptions:

Only the patients who regularly go to the following institutions can receive vaccination there. Please consult with your doctor.

-Ibaraki Clinic Tokai

-Ibarakihigashi National Hospital

## Vaccination at a place other than your place of residence

-Contact the medical institution or facility if you receive the vaccine at the medical institution or facility where you are staying.

-Contact the medical institution if you receive the vaccine at the medical institution where you are being treated for an underlying medical condition.

-Contact the Call Center of the municipality where you live now if you live in a place other than your place of registration. You may be able to receive the vaccine in the area where you live now.

## For those who have recently moved to Tokai Village

If you have recently moved to Tokai Village after receiving two doses in other municipalities and wish to get a booster shot, please contact Tokai Health Center, Ph. 029-282-2797, to apply for the Vaccination Coupon. You can also apply for the Vaccination Coupon through Tokai Village Coronavirus Vaccination Website.

## 4. Online Reservation Available for On-demand Share-ride Taxi Service "Ainori-kun"

Ainori-kun is a service for Tokai Village residents, which provides door-to-door service (from your home or designated location to the destination), at lower fares compared with general commercial taxi service.

## How to use online reservation service
