2. Extension of Administrative Service Time

Date: Every 1st and 3rd Thu.

Time: 8:30 a.m. - 7:00 p.m.

Services and Sections:

Civil Registration Section; Resident registration, seal (hanko) registration, passport issuance, and publishing of other certifications and permissions, procedures of national health insurance and national pension plan and long life medical care for the elderly.

Elderly Welfare Section; Application of long-term care insurance and support of the elderly. **Tax Section;** Issuance of certifications, (local) taxpayer assistance (needs reservation)

Accounting Section; Payment of tax (except national tax, prefectural tax and national pension premiums) and royalties.

Childcare Support Section; Procedures for day-care center, application of children allowance and child-rearing allowance.

Waterworks Section; Procedures to supply public water, payment of water and sewage bills.

3. Coronavirus Vaccination Information

Vaccine for children aged 5 to 11

Children aged 5 to 11 living in Tokai Village will receive Vaccination Coupons in order of age. Appointments can be made once you receive your vaccination coupon.

Children will receive two jabs of Pfizer vaccine designed for children with a period of three weeks between doses free of charge. No other vaccinations can be given for two weeks before and after the COVID vaccinations.

Vaccination for children is not an obligation. Please understand the effects and side effects before deciding for your children to be vaccinated.

Priority coupon delivery for children with underlying medical conditions

Vaccination Coupons will be sent to the above people as soon as possible upon prior application. Please apply online from Tokai Village Coronavirus Vaccination Website or in person to Tokai Health Center if you would like to be given priority for the vaccine.

How to make a reservation

Vaccines will be administered individually at the designated medical institutions only by appointment. Have the coupon ready at hand and make a reservation for the first dose in one of the following three ways.

*The second dose should be scheduled just three weeks after the first dose as a rule.

(3) Reservation Application Form

If you don't need to book immediately, you can also make a reservation by submitting the application form (coupon number required) by fax or in person. The application form is available at Tokai Village Coronavirus Vaccination Website, Tokai Health Center or Tokai Village Office reception desk. You cannot specify a preferred date or time. The assigned date and time will be notified later. We will accept your requests for medical institutions, but we may not be able to provide you with the medical institution of your choice.

In case of cancellation

Up to the day before: Cancel via Tokai Village Coronavirus Vaccination Website or Call Center. On the day: Contact the medical institution where you are scheduled to receive a vaccination.

Location

Medical institutions in the village where vaccinations are available:

-Muto Pediatric Clinic

*Please DO NOT contact these medical institutions directly to make a first-dose vaccination reservation.

*You can receive a vaccine at a medical institution you have never visited before.

Exceptions:

Only the patients who regularly go to the following institutions can receive a vaccination there. Please consult with your doctor.

-Ibarakihigashi National Hospital

What to bring on the appointment day

-Vaccination Coupon and the enclosed documents

-The child's ID (My Number Card, insurance card, etc.)

-Maternal and Child Health Handbook (Boshi Kenko Techo)

-Okusuri Techo (prescription record) if the child is taking medication

*If the child has a fever or feels unwell on the day, contact the medical institution to cancel your appointment.

4. Nuclear Disaster Indoor Evacuation and Evacuation Guidance Drill

At 8:00 a.m. on the drill day, disaster information will be distributed through disaster prevention administrative radio, emergency alert e-mails, and social network services. Please do not confuse it with an actual accident. Also, traffic jams are expected around the drill venues.

All residents and workers in Tokai Village are encouraged to conduct Indoor Evacuation Drills at home or workplace. You need to apply in advance to participate in the Evacuation Guidance Drill. Participants must live, work or go to school in Tokai Village.

Date: Mon. 21 Mar. (Postponed in case of disaster or spread of infection.)

How to conduct Indoor Evacuation at your home or workplace:

When you are advised to carry out "Indoor Evacuation" in the case of a nuclear disaster, please stay inside your home or workplace in order to best reduce possible exposure to radioactive substances.

-Close all the doors and windows.

-Turn off all the ventilation fans

-Turn off the air conditioners that bring in the outside air.

-When you come home from outside, wash your face and hands and change your clothes. Put the clothes in a plastic bag and seal it.

-Try to collect the most accurate updates through disaster prevention administrative radio, emergency alert e-mails, TV, radio, the Internet, etc. Do not be misled by uncertain information from unreliable sources. *No information will be distributed through TV or general radio on the drill day.

8. My Number Point Campaign

Application deadline for issuing My Number Card: 31 Sep. 2022

Application deadline for My Number Point: 28 Feb. 2023

(1) If you apply for issuing your My Number Card for the first time and register a cashless payment service, you are eligible to receive up to 5,000 yen worth of points for your usage of the registered cashless payment service.

(2) If you register your My Number Card as a health insurance card and apply for My Number Point, you will receive up to 7,500 yen worth of points. My Number Point application is

scheduled to start in Jun.

(3) If you register your bank account for receiving benefits from the government at My Number Portal Website, you will receive up to 7,500 yen worth of points. Registration is scheduled to start in Apr.

10. Subsidy for Day Care Fees of Unlicensed Childcare Facilities

Eligible people:

A child of a household who meets all conditions below;

1) The child is a resident of Tokai village.

2) Parents/guardians are unable to take care of the child due to work or illness.

3) The child attended / has been attending an unlicensed childcare facility, which had been filed as required by Child Welfare Act, between Sep. 2021 and Mar. 2022 on a monthly contract (including the ones outside Tokai Village).

4) The fees paid were higher than what was supposed to be paid if the child attended a licensed daycare center.

5) The child is certified or eligible for childcare by Parenting Support New System (except for those who are eligible for Free Preschool Education System).

Subsidy:

Max. 20,000 yen per person per month – half of the difference in the monthly fee of the unlicensed childcare facility and that of a licensed daycare center

Application: Submit the application form with the certificate to prove attendance and payment issued by the unlicensed childcare facility to the Childcare Support Section on the 4th floor of the Village Office by Wed. 13 Apr. Application form and the flyer are available at the Childcare Support Section or can be downloaded from Childcare Support Portal Website "Nobi-nobi Kosodate Cho".
