Pap smear checks (except corpus of the uterus): Women 20 years old as of 1st April, 2014

Breast cancer checks: Women 40 years old as of 1st April, 2014 and women who haven't received checks between 2009 and 2013.

Others: You are also able to receive the checks at the group medical examination by the Tokai-mura Health Center in February and March, 2015.
