4. Extension of Administrative Service Time in Fiscal 2021

Date: Every 1st and 3rd Thu. **Time:** 8:30 a.m. - 7:00 p.m.

Services and Sections:

Civil Registration Section; Resident registration, seal (hanko) registration, passport issuance, and publishing of other certifications and permissions, procedures of national health

insurance and national pension plan and long life medical care for the elderly.

Elderly Welfare Section; Application of long-term care insurance and support of the elderly.

Tax Section; Issuance of certifications, (local) taxpayer assistance (needs reservation)

Accounting Section; Payment of tax (except national tax, prefectural tax and national pension premiums) and royalties.

Childcare Support Section; Procedures for day-care center, application of children allowance and child-rearing allowance.

Waterworks Section; Procedures to supply public water, payment of water and sewage bills. *Health Promotion Section (Tokai Health Center in Tokai Welfare Center "Kizuna"); Issuance of Maternal and Child Health Handbook (boshi kenko techo) /vaccination questionnaires, and other procedures regarding maternal and child health. *Office hours are not extended normally. If you wish to visit the office after hours, please contact in advance to make an appointment.

5. Some Bus Routes and Schedules Revised from 1 Apr.

(1) Main changes

- -"Kasamatsu Sports Park Circulation Lines" will be discontinued.
- -New bus stops "Suwama Kita" and "Midorigaoka-ku Jichikai Shukaijo Mae" will be established.
- -"Midorigaoka Danchi Kitaguchi" will be relocated to the north side.
- -Timetables will be changed in "Floresta Suwama," "Minami-dai," "Midorigaoka" and "Ibarakihigashi National Hospital" Lines.

6. To Those Enrolled in National Health Insurance

- (1) You need to report your withdrawal to the Civil Registration Section to end your membership when you enroll in another Japanese public health insurance system.
- (2) You can still get your National Health Insurance Card issued from Tokai Village if you

move out of the village due to advancing to higher education or admission to a facility. In these cases, you need to report to the Civil Registration Section.

(3) If you use National Health Insurance after you enrolled in another Japanese public health insurance system, you may be asked to return the medical expenses paid by the National Health Insurance.

(4) Please consider choosing inexpensive generic medicines if they are available.
