2. Extension of Administrative Service Time

Services and Sections:

Civil Registration Section; Resident registration, seal (hanko) registration, passport issuance, and publishing of other certifications and permissions.

National Health Insurance and Pension Section; Procedures of national health insurance and national pension plan, issuance of Mother and Child Health

Handbook (boshi kenko techo)

Social Welfare Section; Procedures for day-care center, application of children allowance and child-rearing

Welfare and Nursing Care Section; Application of long-term care insurance and support of the elderly.

Let's learn about pregnancy, childbirth, child care, and share with us your concerns and your experience as a mother.

Date and Content:

1. Mon. 8 Sep, 9:30a.m.-1:00p.m.

Discussion with a midwife about nutrition during pregnancy and cooking hints. Bring an apron and headscarf to cover hair. Reservation for childcare services must be made beforehand.

2. Fri. 12 Sep, 1:30-4:00p.m.

Delivery process and life after childbirth/ child safety seat for cars/ dental checkups and brushing guidance. Reservation for childcare services must be made beforehand.

3. Sat. 20 Sep, 9:20a.m.-noon

Lecture that assists the life with baby after discharge / how to bath a new born/ pregnancy experience for fathers. Bring an apron. There is no childcare services.

Cost: Free

Others: Bring your Mother and Child Health Handbook (boshi kenko techo), the supplementary handbook, pen and notebook.
