2. Extension of Administrative Service Time

Services and Sections:

Civil Registration Section; Resident registration, seal (hanko) registration, passport issuance, and publishing of other certifications and permissions.

Welfare and Insurance Section; Procedures of national health insurance and national pension plan, issuance of Mother and Child Health Handbook (boshi kenko techo)

Childcare Support Section; Procedures for day-care center, application of children allowance and child-rearing

Welfare and Nursing Care Section; Application of long-term care insurance and support of the elderly.

Accounting Section; Payment of tax (except national tax, prefectural tax and national pension premiums) and royalties.

Tax Section; Issuance of certifications, (local) taxpayer assistance (needs reservation)

Waterworks Section; Procedures to supply public water, payment of water and sewage bills.

3. What is “My Number?”

The Japanese government will adopt the Social Security and Tax Number System in order to enhance the social security to people who truly need it, enhance public convenience and develop the efficiency in administration.

Each resident will be notified of his or her own 12-digit Individual Number (nicknamed “My Number”) beginning in October 2015.

Foreigners will be received if he or she had registered as a Tokai-mura resident.

- Tokai-mura will send a notification card showing your Individual Number to the address appearing in your resident record.

- If you receive a notification card, you can receive an Individual Number Card at Tokai Village Office after sending in the application form that will arrive with the card.

Measles-Rubella Vaccinations

Measles is a potentially fatal serious disease that can be prevented by an inoculation of two vaccinations. Children who have already had the first MR vaccination during infancy are recommended to get the second inoculation.

First shot: Children aged 1 year old and over but less than 2 years old

Second shot: Children born between- 2 April, 2009 and 1 April, 2010 (The last preschool year)
