2. Extension of Administrative Service Time

Date: Every 1st and 3rd Thu. 2016

Time: 8:30a.m.-7:00p.m.

Services and Sections:

Civil Registration Section: Resident registration, seal (hanko) registration, passport issuance, and publishing of other certifications and permissions.

Welfare and Insurance Section: Procedures of national health insurance and national pension plan, issuance of Motheral and Child Health Handbook (boshi kenko techo)

Childcare Support Section: Procedures for day-care center, application of children allowance and child-rearing allowance.

Welfare and Nursing Care Section: Application of long-term care insurance and support of the elderly.

Accounting Section: Payment of tax (except national tax, prefectural tax and national pension premiums) and royalties.

Tax Section: Issuance of certifications, (local) taxpayer assistance (needs reservation)

Waterworks Section: Procedures to supply public water, payment of water and sewage bills.

- Rental offices for those who want to start or have just started business.
- A lobby for providing various local information about Tokai-mura.

6. Health Checks for Residents

Residents who missed their health check last year can receive health checks in January.

Date: Thu. 28, Fri. 29 Jan.

Time: 9:30- 11:00 a.m., 1:30- 2:30 p.m.

Place: Tokai-mura Health Center

Eligible People:

- Lung cancer; anyone aged 40 and over (including Tuberculosis check for anyone aged 65 and over)
- Prostate cancer; men between 50 and 79
- Colon cancer; anyone aged 40 and over
- Hepatitis viruses; anyone over 18 who has not been tested in the check provided by Tokai-mura municipality previously
- Checks for young people; anyone between 18 and 39
- Specific health examination; residents with national health insurance between 40 and 74
- Geriatric health examination; anyone aged 75 and over

Cost: Free

Others: If you have free coupons for colon cancer check but have not apply to health checks of this fiscal year yet, you can have a check held for these dates above. If you want to do so, apply at Tokai-mura Health Center and the examination kit will be sent to you.

Application: People who recently moved to Tokai-mura and sheltered from Fukushima pref., and wish to have a health check should apply at Tokai-mura Health Center by Thu. 21 Jan. between 8:30 a.m. and 5:15 p.m. (except Saturdays, Sundays and public holidays).

Anyone who wants receive specific and geriatric health examination should apply at Welfare and Insurance Section.

People who wishes to have specific health examination at assigned clinic or hospital should do so by Sat. 30 Jan. after making a reservation in advance.
