4. Lending service radio receiver

A radio receiver or an emergency radio can be lent out to households for free in Tokai-mura. You can receive announcement from Tokai-mura municipality such as natural disaster information and upcoming event held in Tokai. There are 2 types: One is called "kobetsu jushinki" simple radio receiver, the other one is "bosai radio" emergency radio which also transmits AM and FM and has a built-in flashlight.

If you don't have a radio receiver and want to lend one, apply at Disaster Prevention and Nuclear Energy Safety Section (5F of Tokai-mura Village Office).

If you move out of Tokai-mura, please make inquiries about how to return it.

Broadcast content:

- 1) The notification from Tokai-mura
- 2) The chime informing noon.

- 3) The chime informing the time to go home for kids in the evening.
- 4) Emergency information
- -The information about earthquake, heavy rain or flood.
- The traffic restriction, evacuation advisory and evacuation order when a disaster occurs.
- -The information about a missing person or situation endangering life.
- -Other information about emergency.
