5. Aid for people before and after childbirth

If you are eligible, a helper will come to your house to assist with housework and childcare.

Eligibility:

Residents of Tokai who meet either of the following conditions.

- 1) Woman in pregnancy, or within 16 weeks after childbirth, who cannot do housework due to poor physical condition. Family members are also unable to take care of the baby.
- 2) Woman within 1 year of multiple birth.

6. Changes to light K-car taxes

2016 tax notices for small cars will be sent out to owners.

Payment deadline: Tue. 31 May, 2016

Payment location: Payments can be made at designated banks, some convenience stores, and the Japan Post Bank (in Kanto and Yamanashi prefectures) indicated on the back of the notice.

Anyone who has not received or has lost the tax notice, or who has disposed of their car before Fri. 1 April 2016, please inquire at the Tax Section.

The tax rate for light vehicles (three or four wheels) has been changed from fiscal 2016, and depends on the category of the vehicle or its initial registration date.

(1) Mopeds, motorcycles, etc., and small special motor vehicles

- 1) Mopeds
- 50cc or less will be 2,000 yen (current tax: 1,000 yen)
- 90cc or less will be 2,000 yen (current tax: 1,200 yen)
- 125cc or less will be 2,400 yen (current tax: 1,600 yen)
- Mini-cars will be 3,700 yen (current tax: 2,500 yen)
- 2) Small special motor vehicles
- Farm vehicles will be 2,000 yen (current: 1,600 yen)
- Small special motor vehicles, except farm vehicles: for specialized operation (forklifts etc.) will be 5,900 yen (current tax: 4,700 yen)
- 3) Motorcycles and scooters
- Small motorcycles 250cc or less will be 3,600 yen (current tax: 2,400 yen)
- Small motorcycles over 250cc will be 6,000 yen (current tax: 4,000 yen)

(2) Light vehicles: tricycles, four wheelers

The tax rate for vehicles registered before March 31, 2015 will not be changed. However, an aging vehicle tax rate will be applied if 13 years have passed since initial registration (except for light vehicles classified as: electric, natural gas, methanol, mixed methanol, or hybrid). A greening special exemption will be applied to eco-light vehicles.
