About medical and welfare system (Maru-Fuku) of Ibaraki, the income limit of child and pregnant woman will be lightened from October. And accordingly, "Medical and Welfare Recipient Certificate" will be changed/modified. Reviewing by the new amount of income limit will be held, then new recipient certificate will be sent in the end of September to people who changed from non-pertinence to pertinence about this new system.

To guardian who have a recipient certificate (Maru-Toku) of non-pertinence for Ibaraki system;

-Procedure at the counter is not necessary.

-Use the current certificate during Sep., and until Sat.1 Oct., shred it and throw it. Please use the new one from Sat. 1 Oct.

-If you are judged non-pertinence (Maru-Toku), the new certificate won't be sent. Please keep using the current certificate.
