2. Extension of Administrative Service Time

Date: Every 1st and 3rd Thu. 2017

Time: 8:30a.m.-7:00p.m.

Services and Sections:

Civil Registration Section; Resident registration, seal (hanko) registration, passport issuance, and publishing of other certifications and permissions.

Welfare and Insurance Section; Procedures of national health insurance and national pension plan and long life medical care for the elderly.

Welfare and Nursing Care Section; Application of long-term care insurance and support of the elderly.

Tax Section; Issuance of certifications, (local) taxpayer assistance (needs reservation)

Accounting Section; Payment of tax (except national tax, prefectural tax and national pension premiums) and royalties.

Childcare Support Section; Procedures for day-care center, application of children allowance and child-rearing allowance.

Waterworks Section; Procedures to supply public water, payment of water and sewage bills.

Tokai Health Center; Procedures of vaccination, health check and healthcare for mother and child, and issuance of Maternal and Child Health Handbook (boshi kenko techo)

3. Meeting for the Briefing about and Distribution of Stable Iodine Tablets

Stable iodine tablets will be distributed to residents who live in Tokai Village by Ibaraki Prefecture and Tokai Village. Distribution is limited to the residents who didn't receive the stable iodine tablet in the last fiscal year. In order to receive stable iodine tablets, participation in the distribution meeting is required and a set of information papers should be brought to the meeting. The set had been sent out by the beginning of Oct. 2016.

A household representative (18 years old and above) can receive stable iodine tablets for all members of family, in case the household takes the numbered tickets and check sheets of the whole family.

Based on the policies of the central government, stable iodine tablets will be taken ONLY following doctor's direction.

What is stable iodine tablet?

A stable iodine tablet is prescription product for preventing radioactive deficiency by radioactive iodine. The stable iodine tablet will be distributed in advance and taken quickly in case of a nuclear disaster.

[Notice to the guardian who have child of age 2 and under]

Because a stable iodine jelly has been made for children of age 2 and under from this fiscal year, even if you already received the stable iodine tablets, the stable iodine jelly will be distributed for your child.

*This jelly will not be distributed for children who are 3 years old on the date of distribution.

[People who lost/do not have number ticket]

People who lost the information papers should ask the staffs on the same day in order to get your number ticket reissued.
