2. Extension of Administrative Service Time

Date: Every 1st and 3rd Thu. **Time:** 8:30 a.m.-7:00 p.m.

Services and Sections:

Civil Registration Section; Resident registration, seal (hanko) registration, passport issuance, and publishing of other certifications and permissions.

Welfare and Insurance Section; Procedures of national health insurance and national pension plan and long life medical care for the elderly.

Welfare and Nursing Care Section; Application of long-term care insurance and support of the elderly.

Tax Section; Issuance of certifications, (local) taxpayer assistance (needs reservation)

Accounting Section; Payment of tax (except national tax, prefectural tax and national pension premiums) and royalties.

Childcare Support Section; Procedures for day-care center, application of children allowance and child-rearing allowance.

Waterworks Section; Procedures to supply public water, payment of water and sewage bills.

Tokai Health Center; Procedures of vaccination, health check and healthcare for mother and child, and issuance of Maternal and Child Health Handbook (boshi kenko techo)

3. Briefing about Distribution of Stable Iodine Tablets

Stable iodine tablets will be distributed to Tokai residents who have not received yet by the Ibaraki Prefecture and Tokai Village.

A household representative (18 years old or over) can receive stable iodine tablets for all members of the family, if that is the case, the household has to bring the numbered tickets and check sheets of the whole family.

Based on the policies of the central government, stable iodine tablets will be taken ONLY following doctor's direction.

What is a stable iodine tablet?

A stable iodine tablet is prescribed product for preventing radioactive deficiency by radioactive iodine. The stable iodine tablet will be distributed in advance and taken quickly in case of a nuclear disaster.

* The people who had been received the set in Oct. 2017 should also bring them to the meeting.

[Notice to the guardian who have child of under 3 years old]

A stable iodine jelly has been made for children of under 3 years old since last fiscal year. The stable iodine jelly will be distributed for your child, even if you have already received the stable iodine tablets.

[People who lost/do not have number ticket]

People who lost the information papers should ask the staffs on the same day in order to get your number ticket reissued.
