4. Subsidized Rubella Vaccination

Eligible people:

Applicants should meet one of the following conditions.

- 1. People who want to become pregnant.
- 2. People who are the husband of a pregnant woman.
- 3. People who are the husband of a woman who wants to become a pregnant.

And applicants also should meet all of the following conditions.

- 1. People who were born before 1 Apr. 1990.
- 2. People who have never caught rubella, and have never received rubella

vaccination (including people who can not confirm the vaccination record).

- 3. People who are registered as a resident from receiving vaccination date to application date.
- *Women who are or may be pregnant will not receive the vaccination.
- *Contraception will be required for 2 months after the vaccination.

Subsidy amount: Half of the vaccination fee (5,000 yen maximum)

Term: Apr. 2018 - Fri. 29 Mar. 2019

*Please make sure that you can not apply after Mon. 1 Apr. 2019.

Procedure of application:

- 1. Receive vaccination of rubella or measles-rubella at medical facility.
- 2. Pay the vaccination fee at medical facility and get a receipt and certificates of medical remuneration "Shinryo Houshu Meisaisho".
- *Stamp of medical facility will be required on the receipt which is hand writing.
- 3. Apply at Tokai Health Center. You have to bring the receipt, Shinryo Houshu Meisaisho, your bank book and Hanko.
- 4. After all procedures, the subsidy amount will be transferred to your bank account.

Other: Please check the person's name who received vaccination, receiving date, name of vaccination and number of fee on the receipt. You need all information on it to apply.

- 4. Parents or guardians have long-term nursing care obligations.
- 5. Parents or guardians are working in disaster recovery.
- 6. Parents or guardians are job-hunting or in the process of starting a business continually.
- 7. Parents or guardians are studying at any school or in job training.
- 8. Parents or guardians are abusive.

Capacity: A few places are available at each of daycare centers.

*This differs depending on the age of infant or toddler and the institution.
