2. Extension of Administrative Service Time

Date: Every 1st and 3rd Thu.

Time: 8:30 a.m. - 7:00 p.m.

Services and Sections:

Civil Registration Section: Resident registration, seal (hanko) registration, passport issuance, and publishing of other certifications and permissions, procedures of national health insurance and national pension plan and long life medical care for the elderly.

Elderly Welfare Section: Application of long-term care insurance and support of the elderly.

Tax Section: Issuance of certifications, (local) taxpayer assistance (needs reservation)

Accounting Section: Payment of tax (except national tax, prefectural tax and national pension premiums) and royalties.

Childcare Support Section: Procedures for day-care center, application of children allowance and child-rearing allowance.

Waterworks Section: Procedures to supply public water, payment of water and sewage bills.

3. Nuclear Disaster Evacuation Drill for a Widespread Area

Nuclear disaster evacuation drill will be held in a widespread area.

In the drill, we will give some information about disaster prevention through the disaster prevention administrative radio, emergency alert e-mail, and social network service. Traffic jams will be expected around the venues.

Thank you for your understanding and cooperation.

Participants: Residents in Tokai Village who have applied for the drill beforehand.

Date: Mon. 24 Jun. (Cancelled or postponed in case of disasters.)

Time: 7:30 a.m. - 3:15 p.m. (estimated)

Place: Tokai Village Office, Ishigami Community Center, Nakamaru Community Center, Ishigami Elementary School, Muramatsu Elementary School, Tsukubamirai City Yawara Community Center, Tsukubamirai City Miraidaira Community Center, Toride-shi Fujishiro public hall.

How to drill:

1. Announcement at 8:00 a.m. (estimated); You will be given some information through the disaster prevention administrative radio, emergency alert e-mail and SNS.

2. Evacuation at 8:30 a.m. (estimated); Walk or drive to Ishigami or Nakamaru Community Center. A bus will take you to the evacuation shelter (Tsukubamirai City Yawara Community Center).
