2. Extension of Administrative Service Time

Services and Sections:

Civil Registration Section; Resident registration, seal (hanko) registration, passport issuance, and publishing of other certifications and permissions, procedures of national health insurance and national pension plan and long life medical care for the elderly.

Elderly Welfare Section; Application of long-term care insurance and support of the elderly.

Tax Section; Issuance of certifications, (local) taxpayer assistance (needs reservation)

Accounting Section; Payment of tax (except national tax, prefectural tax and national pension premiums) and royalties.

3. Nuclear Disaster Evacuation Drill for a Widespread Area

Nuclear disaster evacuation drill will be held in a widespread area.

In the drill, we will give some information about disaster prevention through the disaster prevention administrative radio, emergency alert e-mail, and social network service. Traffic jams will be expected around the venues, Ishigami and Nakamaru Community Centers.

Participants: Residents in Tokai Village who have applied for the drill beforehand.

Date: Mon. 24 Jun. (Cancelled or postponed on Mon. 1 Jul. in case of disasters.)

Time: 8:00 a.m. - 3:15 p.m. (estimated)

Place: Tokai Village Office, Ishigami Community Center, Nakamaru Community Center, Ishigami Elementary School, Muramatsu Elementary School, Tsukubamirai City Yawara Community Center, Tsukubamirai City Miraidaira Community Center, Toride-shi Fujishiro public hall.

4. 2019 Municipal/Prefectural Residence Tax (Individual) Notice

Residence tax is calculated based on a person's income in the previous year, and is levied on all residents including foreigner who have completed resident registration in Tokai Village as of January 1.

The tax is calculated based on the amount of income earned from January through December of the previous year, so it is imposed even no income in this year.

The tax notice will be mailed from Wed. 12 Jun.. Anyone who has not received the tax notice by Fri. 21 Jun., please inquire it at the Tax Section.

Payment: If you want to use direct debit to pay tax, please bring the necessary documents.

8. Reduction Day Care Fees of Private Kindergarten

The household whose child is a private kindergarten pupil can get a reduction of the private kindergarten fee that is attending according to the amount of their municipal residence tax.

Eligible people:

Household who meets all conditions below

- 1) A household who is a resident of Tokai village.
- 2) The child is 3-5 years old (as of 2 Apr. 2019) or 3 years old on this year to be admitted into a kindergarten as a pupil.
- 3) The amount of residence tax to be paid by the household in 2019 meets the standard amount.

Notice: A household is not eligible whose child is enrolled a kindergarten which has been receiving a benefit from public expense by Parenting Support new System. Please check on the kindergarten.

Subsidy: 31,100 yen - 308,000 yen a year per person

Others: Subsidies payment date will be announced later.

Applications: Fill the application form from kindergartens and submit it to the kindergarten by Fri. 28 Jun.. A municipal Taxation certificate of your previous city should be submitted with the application form if you have moved to Tokai Village after 2 Jan. 2019.
