4. Policies to make Preschool Education and Daycare Services Free from October

Under the program, the government will make preschool education and daycare services free for all children between 3 and 5 years old starting in October.

Eligible people:

As of 1 Apr. 2019, Children

1) between 3 and 5 years old

2) 2 years old and under who are certified to need daycare, and are in household exempted from resident tax.

Others:

- The fees for ingredients such as lunch and snacks, school bus and events should be paid by a guardian.

- The information of amount and how to pay will be announced by your kindergarten/ daycare center/ kodomoen.

Application: The information to apply will be given through your kindergarten/daycare center/kodomoen or Tokai Village official website.

Rice fields in Tokai Village will be sprayed aerially with insecticide by unmanned helicopters.
