3. Mayor's guidelines for Tokai Village citizens.

To avoid the spread of infectious diseases.

- ① Do not go out of your house unless for essential needs.

- ② Avoid gathering in the following three situations:
“Tightly shut space”, “A crowded location” and “In a close situation with another person”.
- ③ Wash your hands and follow proper coughing etiquette.

4. Light Vehicle Tax

Light vehicle tax bill will be sent out to owners soon.

Please make sure to make payment at banks, convenience stores or the Japan Post Bank (in Kanto and Yamanashi pref.) designated on the back of the notice by Mon. 1 Jun.

The amount will be deducted from your account on Mon. 1 Jun. only for bank transfer registrants.

Anyone who has not received or has lost the tax notice, or who has received it for a scrapped/disused car or a car that changed ownership before 1 Apr. 2020, please inquire at Tax Section, Tokai Village Office.

Regarding reduction and exemption for the disabled, please contact Tax Section.
