Garbage Disposal Method

Basic rules

By promoting garbage reduction and effective utilization of recycling, we strive to build a recycle oriented society further contributing to a better living environment with the circulation basis and pollution free city development of Tokai Village.

Here, we would like to introduce the basic rules for residents of Tokai Village when putting out garbage. Follow the rules on how to separate garbage and put it out at the designated date and time.

Garbage Disposal Place

Garbage Collection Site

Garbage collection sites are administrated and maintained by users in each area. Please cooperate with us as you can only put out garbage at the garbage collection site you use. Also, please note that recyclables cannot be put out at garbage collection sites. (If you are unsure where to drop off the waste, please ask a neighbour.)

Recyclable Station

Recyclable stations are exclusive stations for recyclables established by each neighborhood community association. Please check where the neighborhood community association in your area is before putting out recyclables. (Refer to page 8 to 15 for each item disposal method)

* The number of collections vary depending on the neighborhood community association.

Note General waste from business cannot be put out at garbage collection sites and recyclable stations.

Garbage Disposal Day

Please check the "Recyclables/Trash Collection Schedules" for the date of disposing of garbage and recyclables.

If you do not have the "Recyclables/Trash Collection Schedules", you can get one at the Tokai Village Clean Center, the General Information Center of the City Hall, or the Environmental Policy Division.

Garbage Disposal Time

Please put garbage out by 8:30 a.m. on the scheduled day.
(Recyclables will be taken to the recyclable station from 7 a.m. to 8:30 a.m.)



Garbage Disposal Amount

The amount of garbage that can be put out at one time is up to 50kg.

When putting out more than 50kg of garbage material, please directly bring non-burnable garbage, oversized garbage, and recyclables to the Tokai Village Clean Center, and burnable garbage to the Hitachinaka-Tokai Clean Center.

Note

- When putting out a large amount of garbage, please inquire with the Tokai Village Clean Center beforehand. (See back cover)
- Because you cannot bring in the garbage that originated outside of Tokai Village, please inquire with the municipality from which it came from.

About Garbage Collection Site

Notification

Collection site at general residential housing

After choosing the place through community discussions and obtaining the necessary acceptance and permission, a notification will be delivered.

Collection site at collective housing

The landlord or property management company will be the notifier.

Notification documents include

- ① Notification note
- ② Acceptance form of the landowner
- ③ User List

* These forms can be downloaded from the Tokai Village website.


Procedure

- 1** Find a place to establish a collection site. In principle, the number of households required for establishment of a collection site is more than 10 general residential houses and more than 4 collective houses.
- 2** Obtain consent from the landowner and other relevant parties.
- 3** Notify the Tokai Village Clean Center (Zero Waste Promotion Section).
- 4** After the on-site confirmation made by the Tokai Village Clean Center staff and the acceptance form is issued, the collection will begin.

* It takes about 2 weeks from notification to start collection.

Administration and maintenance of the collection site

- All users are responsible for maintenance and cleaning.
- Let's take measures to prevent injury by birds and animal (crows, etc.).
- Do not put out garbage without asking users of the collection site, as it may cause trouble.



There is a signboard at the collection site. Please contact the Tokai village clean center for replacement of old contents, age deteriorated items, etc.

Garbage Segregation in Tokai Village

Garbage segregation in Tokai Village is divided into 4 categories: burnable garbage, non-burnable garbage, oversized garbage, and recyclables.

Garbage Disposal Method

Burnable garbage

Main items

- Kitchen garbage/Grass clippings
- Paper waste that cannot be used as recyclables
- Plastic products, etc.

Collect to garbage collection site twice a week

Main items

- Pottery and porcelain
- Glassware, etc.

Collect to garbage collection site twice a month

Oversized garbage

- Desks/futon
 - Bicycles
 - Microwave ovens, etc.
- * Items that do not fit into the designated garbage bag

Collect to garbage collection site twice a month

* Garbage that exceeds the collection site limit should be brought directly to the Tokai Village Clean Center.

* Recyclables station is established by each neighborhood community association.

* To reduce waste generation and promote the efficient use of limited resources, we offer financial incentives within our budget to organisations (e.g. local authorities, children's associations) that sort and collect recyclable resources (Recyclable Resource Sorting and Collection Incentive).

Recycling Initiatives

Bringing garbage to the center


Please bring large amounts of garbage over 50kg directly to the Hitachinaka-Tokai Clean Center or the Tokai Village Clean Center. In such cases, a processing fee will be charged depending on the weight.

Burnable Garbage

Please bring directly to the Hitachinaka-Tokai Clean Center.

Non-burnable garbage, oversized garbage, recyclables, pruned branches and leaves (Refer to P5)

Please separate the garbage and bring it directly to the Tokai Village Clean Center.



- Please use "transparent or semi-transparent bags" when bringing garbage in bags. (You cannot bring in black bags or cardboard boxes.) Designated garbage bags and oversized garbage disposal tickets are not required.
- If you are going to generate more than 1,000 kg (1 ton) of garbage, you must notify the Tokai Village Clean Center at least 7 days prior to the carry-in date. After the notification is submitted, the village staff will check the site and issue instructions for carrying-in.
- Industrial waste cannot be brought to the Tokai Village Clean Center.



How to use the Tokai Village Clean Center

- When using the Tokai Village Clean Center for the first time, please present identification such as your driver's license to the staff member (We cannot accept waste generated outside the village).
- Please drive straight from the main entrance to where the staff member will be standing (the yellow floor is the scale). Inform the staff member of what you wish to put out and follow their instructions.

If you bring a mixture of recyclables and non-burnable/oversized garbage

You may now leave



* If you bring only recyclables or only non-burnable/oversized garbage, unload it as instructed by the staff member after the first weighing, and then finish after the second weighing.

Important notice when putting out burnable garbage

- Please put out paper containers and packaging marked with the paper symbol (e.g. candy boxes) as recyclables.
- Please put out paper containers and packaging marked with the plastic symbol (see P.12 for details) as recyclables.



Branches (branches and leaves) Disposal Method

Method

1

Put out as burnable garbage at collection sites [Bundle and Put out]

- It must be within 10cm in diameter, within 50cm in length, and upto 50kg for single garbage disposal.
- Please bundle tightly and attach the "Oversized Garbage Disposal Ticket".
- Please put out on burnable garbage collection days.

Thickness of one piece: within 10cm



Length within 50cm

- Garbage that can be put out at collection sites is limited to those coming from ordinary households. (Items disposed of as a result of business activities cannot be put out)

Method

2

Put out as burnable garbage at collection sites [Put in a bag]

- It must be within 10cm in diameter, within 50cm in length, and upto 50kg for single garbage disposal.
- Please put your waste in designated garbage bags or other sturdy bags.
- Please tie the top of the bag.
- If you use a bag other than a designated garbage bag, be sure to label it "枝" (branches) and attach a "Oversized Garbage Disposal Ticket." (Waste other than branches and leaves will not be collected.)
- Please put out on burnable garbage collection days.

- Garbage that can be put out at collection sites is limited to those coming from ordinary households. (Items disposed of as a result of business activities cannot be put out)

Method

3

Bring directly to the Tokai Village Clean Center

- The length is within 1m (Please drop off into the receiving container by yourself)
- There is an acceptance limitation when bringing a large amount (Up to 2 light trucks per day)
- Agricultural products (vegetables, etc.) are not accepted. (Please bring it to the Hitachinaka-Tokai Clean Center)
- Tree roots cannot be accepted. (Please shred them, place them in a designated garbage bag, and put them out as burnable garbage at collection points or at Hitachinaka-Tokai Clean Center.)
- Free of charge within 50kg

There is no thickness limitation



Length within 1m

- Limited to items from ordinary households. (Items disposed of as a result of business activities cannot be put out)

Method

4

Bring directly to Hitachinaka-Tokai Clean Center

- It must be within 2m in length and within 10cm in diameter.
- There is no limit to the accepted amount.
- Free of charge within 50kg

Point

- Please wrap hazardous items such as razors, needles, and glass in newspaper, clearly label "キケン" (Danger), and place them in a designated bag.
- If there are batteries in it, please make sure to remove them.
- Items that do not fit into the designated garbage bag should be put out as "oversized garbage" with the disposal ticket put on.
- Please put out recyclables (bottles, cans, etc.) that are still dirty after washing as non-burnable garbage.

Point

- In general, burnable and non-burnable garbage that does not fit into the designated garbage bags, **but is the total length+width+height, is less than 3m and less than 50kg**, can be put out at garbage collection sites. In that case, please put out with the “粗大ごみ処理券” (Oversized Garbage Disposal Ticket) put on.
- For items that cannot be put out at the collection sites due to their size and weight, please bring them directly to the Tokai Village Clean Center.

PET bottles (Recyclables)

Please put out at recyclables stations from 7 a.m. to 8:30 a.m. on recyclables collection day according to the Recyclables/Trash Collection Schedules.



This is the identifying mark

Items classified as PET bottles

Soft drinks

Soft drinks (including coffee drinks, tea drinks, etc.), fruit juice drinks, milk beverages, drink-type fermented milk, probiotic drinks, etc.

Particular seasonings

Soy sauce, processed soy sauce products (noodle soup base, etc.), mirin-style seasonings, vinegar seasonings, dressing-type seasonings (non-oil), etc.

Alcoholic

Alcoholic beverages (shochu, hon mirin, Western sake, sake, etc.)

Correct Disposal Method


1 Remove the caps and labels. (Let's separate and put out caps and labels separately.)



2 Make sure to wash with water.



● Net container collection



For PET bottles

- * There is no need to remove the ring at the bottom of the cap if it proves to be troublesome.
- * Please do not crush plastic bottles.

Items cannot be handled as PET bottles (recyclables)

- Plastics other than PET bottles, trays, and detergents, etc. → regard as **Plastic Containers and Packaging**
- Items that do not remove dirt → regard as **Burnable garbage**
- PET bottles written with permanent marker or used for handicraft → regard as **Burnable garbage**



Fluorescent tubes, incandescent light bulbs, mercury thermometers, dry cell batteries (Recyclables)

Please put out at recyclables stations from 7 a.m. to 8:30 a.m. on recyclables collection day according to the Recyclables/Trash Collection Schedules.

Fluorescent tubes, light bulbs


Please put them in the case when purchasing, tie them up, and put them out. (Compact fluorescent bulbs can also be disposed of)

Mercury thermometers

Please write “体温計” (thermometer) on the bag, etc. so that we can identify the contents.



Dry cell batteries



❌ Waste that cannot be put out at recycling stations

- LED lighting → regard as **Non-burnable garbage**
- Broken fluorescent tubes or incandescent bulbs → regard as **Non-burnable garbage**
- Small rechargeable battery → **Please bring the waste directly to the Tokai Village Clean Center**


- Target: Nickel-cadmium batteries, nickel-metal hydride batteries, lithium-ion batteries, mobile power banks
- Disposal guide: Please cover the metal terminals of affected batteries with tape to insulate them.
- Other: Please take damaged, swollen, or water-damaged battery packs directly to the Tokai Village Clean Center.

Used paper, clothes (recyclables)

Please put out at recyclables stations from 7 a.m. to 8:30 a.m. on recyclables collection day according to the Recyclables/Trash Collection Schedules.


Newspapers/newspaper flyer inserts



Point!

- Even if the newspaper is packed in a bag, it should be tied crosswise with a string.
- Please put out pamphlets and catalogs other than flyer inserts as "Magazines and books, etc."


Magazines, books, copy paper, notebooks



Point!

- Tie crosswise with a string.
- Remove the clips.

Paper containers and packaging (wrapping paper, paper bags, candy boxes, etc.)




Point!

- There is no need to bundle or tie them up.
- Put them directly in the collection nets.



This is the identifying mark

Cardboard boxes



Point!

- Do not put anything other than cardboard boxes together.
- Please flatten them out and tie crosswise with a string.
- Be sure to remove all metal fittings.



This is the identifying mark

Paper cartons (milk cartons, etc.)



Bundle method for paper cartons

- 1000cc packs... bundle into 30 pieces
- 500cc packs... bundle into 45 pieces

Point!

- Please wash, dry and open them up.
- Items containing silver inside should be put out as burnable garbage.


What about packs and fractions other than those above?

You can put them out without bundling!

Clothes, etc.



Point!

- Please pack out clothes, etc. in transparent and semi-transparent bags.
- Please tie the mouth of the bag tightly.

★ Clothes and cloth products that should not be put out as recyclables

Items to be put out in burnable garbage

- Toilet cover
- Stuffed toy
- Dust cloth (the one used for a long time)
- Cloth towels used for pets, etc.
- Items stained with mud, oil, paint, etc.
- Fabric scraps (sewing cabbage)
- Plastic raincoats
- Pillows
- Zabuton (square floor cushion)
- Cotton padded clothes, leather goods, etc.

Items to be put out in oversized garbage

- Carpets
- Underlay for kotatsu table
- Quilts and mattresses
- Electric blankets
- Pet mats, etc.

Plastic Containers and Packaging

Please put out at recyclables stations from 7 a.m. to 8:30 a.m. on recyclables collection day according to the Recyclables/Trash Collection Schedules.



This is the identifying mark
* In the case of composite products, there may be cases where all of them are displayed together on the exterior.

Items classified as plastic containers and packaging (recyclables)

Lunch box containers, etc.

Point

- Make sure to put out plastic products without plastic marks as burnable garbage.
- Never mix plastic electrical appliances. (There is a risk of fire).
- Let's put them out after washing off the dirt and drying them out.
- Please put them out as burnable garbage when you cannot clean them properly and find it hard to wash the dirt off the items.
- Never mix batteries, lighters, razors, syringes, etc. (There is a risk of fire and injury to workers.)

Correct disposal method

1 Please check whether there is a plastic mark.



2 Let's wash off the dirt.



3 When it dries, please put it out in a transparent or semi-transparent bag.



✗ Items cannot be handled as plastic containers and packaging (recyclables) ➡ should be put out as burnable garbage.

The product itself or a part of it



Polyethylene buckets, polyethylene tanks, CD cases, flower pots, PVC pipes, rain gutters, plastic toys, pencil cases (pencil boxes), glasses cases, etc.

Rather than products, items used for service purposes



Cleaning bags, delivery containers and packaging, etc.

Items that are not "products"



Envelopes containing letters and direct mail, items containing prizes, items containing things brought from home, etc.

Items that wrap less than one-half of the entire product



Vegetable binding tape etc.

Items that are physically separated from "containers" and "packaging"



Dividers for Bento boxes, nigiri sushi, etc.

Please put out at recyclables stations from 7 a.m. to 8:30 a.m. on recyclables collection day according to the Recyclables/Trash Collection Schedules.

- Beer bottles and 1.8-liter bottles (returnable bottles) should be put out as they are if they come with a case.
- You can put out bottles of oil-free dressing.
- Please put out nail polish bottles as non-burnable garbage.

Correct Disposal Method

Empty cans Disposal Method

Can lids (pull tabs) can also be put out as empty cans.

Remove foreign objects (cigarette butts, straws, etc.) and wash with water.

Correct spray cans disposal method

Please completely use up the contents, and put out without making a hole.

1

Empty the cans

- Use up the product.
- If it is not used up, empty the can by removing the contents.
- * If the can cannot be emptied, please confirm with the customer service center or the vendor listed on the product.

2

Confirm whether the can is empty

- Shake the can and listen to the sound.
- * If you hear a rattling sound, there is a possibility that the contents are still inside.

3

Use the gas vent cap to vent the gas

- Carefully read the instructions on how to use the gas vent cap written on the product.
- * If there is no cap, press the button to completely release the gas.
- Work outdoors in a well-ventilated, fire-free place.
- Prevent it from spreading around by spraying on tissue, newspapers, etc.

4

Put out as recyclables

- On the recyclables collection day, put them out in a net container for spray can collection.



● If you separate your recyclables properly, they can be recycled into a variety of products.

Burnable Garbage

Ash remaining after incineration (incinerator ash) can be recycled as raw material for cement or roadbed material (road base).

Products subject to home appliance recycling

(Air conditioner, TV, Refrigerator/
Freezer, Washing machine/Clothes dryer)

Metals (e.g. iron, copper, and aluminium) are used for automotive parts and components for new household appliances.

Plastics are used in new appliance casings, carpets, insulation materials, as well as motor parts, electrical wiring, and insulation materials.

Collection of small home appliances

In Tokai Village, used small home appliances are collected and recycled in accordance with the "Small Home Appliance Recycling Law".

Collection method

- Bringing garbage directly to the Tokai Village Clean Center
- Put out as non-burnable garbage or oversized garbage at the collection site (PCs and mobile phones are not allowed)
- Put in collection boxes

About collection boxes

- Boxes are installed at the Tokai Village Hall, each community center, and the Aeon Tokai branch (on the 3rd floor).
- They are 15 cm long x 30 cm wide and have a dedicated slot for mobile phones.



Items to be collected

- Power supplies, chargers, small electrical appliances using batteries

PCs, mobile phones, digital cameras, video cameras, microwave ovens, electric vacuum cleaners, jar rice cookers, portable game machines, portable music players, electronic dictionaries, car navigation systems, AC adapters, MD players, IC recorders, VICS units, etc.



Point

- Exclude 4 types of home appliances [TVs, refrigerators (freezers), air conditioners, washing machines (clothes dryers)].
- Computers and mobile phones cannot be put out at collection points as non-burnable garbage or oversized garbage. Please bring them directly to the Tokai Village Clean Center or put them in collection boxes.
- Please delete the data from your PC, mobile phone, etc. at your own risk.
- Please remove any removable cells or batteries.
- Business-use computers are classified as industrial waste and cannot be put out, even if brought directly.

About the PC Recycling System

If you have a PC recycling mark, you may also use this service.

Procedure

- ① Contact the support desk of the manufacturer of your PC.
 - ② At a later date, the manufacturer will mail you an "Eco Yu-Pack denpyo" delivery slip. Please pack your items yourself and request the post office for door-to-door pickup or bring them to the post office.
- Even for PCs with the "PC recycling mark," if the manufacturer is unable to collect the PCs due to bankruptcy or other reasons, the owner must pay a collection and recycling fee.
 - A collection and recycling fee is required for PCs that do not bear the PC recycling mark. For more information, please visit the website of the PC3R Promotion Association.

Please bring lithium-ion batteries to the Tokai Village Clean Center

Fires caused by lithium-ion batteries are increasing

In recent years, there have been frequent fires and other incidents caused by lithium batteries and products using lithium batteries at waste disposal facilities and waste collection and transportation vehicles.

(* Lithium batteries are synonymous with lithium-ion batteries)



How to Identify Lithium-ion Batteries




Li-ion

To identify lithium-ion batteries, first look for the "recycling mark" on the battery. Some products manufactured before the law came into effect may not have the recycling mark.

Batteries labelled "Li-ion," "リチウム蓄電池 (Lithium battery)," "Li-イオン (Li-ion)," or "リチウムイオン (Lithium-ion)" are also eligible for collection and recycling.

How to Put out Lithium-ion Batteries (Tokai Village)

If you bring removed lithium-ion batteries to the Tokai Village Clean Center, please insulate the battery's metal terminals with tape and place them in the yellow recycling box at the entrance to the clean center, or hand them over directly to staff members on the platform.

* Swollen or deformed lithium-ion batteries (including mobile power banks) must be handed directly to a staff member.

* Nickel-cadmium batteries (sealed Ni-Cd batteries) and nickel-metal hydride batteries (sealed Ni-MH batteries) are also accepted.





Household appliances containing fluorocarbons other than the four designated items

- Appliances such as dehumidifiers, air coolers, water chillers, and air purifiers may contain fluorocarbons used as refrigerants.
- Household appliances containing fluorocarbons cannot be put out at the Tokai Village Clean Center. Please consult retailers, manufacturers, or specialist disposal companies.
- * Please do not bring these to the Tokai Village Clean Center or put them out at waste collection points.

How to check for the presence of fluorocarbons

- Check the nameplate sticker (which shows the device's name and model number) or instruction manual affixed to the product. If you're unsure, contact the manufacturer or retailer.
- Products that use fluorocarbons are often labelled with the following:
"冷媒ガス(Refrigerant gas)," "フロンガス(Fluorocarbon gas)," "R-12," "R-134a," "R-22," "R-32," etc. (all start with R), "HFC-134a," "HCFC-22," "CFC-12," etc.

Difficult-to-dispose materials/hazardous materials, etc.

Batteries, tires, cinders, motorcycles, farm equipment, gas cylinders, Containers that contain or have contained pesticides, deleterious chemicals, agricultural waste vinyl, Ships, automobile parts, etc.

General waste from business activities cannot be put out at garbage collection sites. Bring it directly to the Hitachinaka-Tokai Clean Center or Tokai Village Clean Center, or request a general waste collection and licensed transport contractor.

* Industrial waste cannot be brought to the Tokai Village Clean Center. Please contact a specialist.

Waste Disposal and Public Cleansing Act (excerpt)

- Dispose of waste generated from business activities at your own risk.
- Strive to reduce waste by actively recycling waste generated by your business activities.
- When manufacturing, processing, selling, etc., it is necessary to consider that the product will eventually become waste, and to ensure that the disposal of the product will not become difficult if it is discharged as waste.

Let's stop illegal dumping and outdoor garbage burning!

Illegal dumping is a crime!

Illegal dumping is prohibited under Article 16 of the "Waste Disposal and Public Cleansing Act".

Please do not dump garbage illegally, regardless of whether you are an individual or a corporation, as it causes deterioration of the living environment and is a nuisance to local residents.

The Tokai Village Clean Center distributes illegal dumping prevention signs to landowners in the village who are troubled by illegal dumping, so please consult with us.

Q Garbage was illegally dumped on my property. Who will take charge of disposing of the garbage that was illegally dumped?

A If the illegal dumpers cannot be found, the landowner must dispose of the illegally dumped. To prevent illegal dumping, please cooperate with the proper management of the property on a regular basis by weeding, patrolling, etc.



In principle, outdoor garbage burning are prohibited!

Outdoor garbage burning is prohibited under Article 16-2 of the "Waste Disposal and Public Cleansing Act" with some exceptions.

Exceptions to the prohibition of outdoor garbage burning.

- ① Incineration of waste necessary for national or local governments to manage their facilities (E.g., burning grass in the riverbeds or near the roads)
- ② Incineration of waste necessary for prevention of earthquakes, wind and flood damage, fires and other disasters, emergency measures, and restoration.
- ③ Incineration of waste necessary for performing customs or religious events (E.g., shimenawa (sacred straw ropes), kadomatsu (new year gate pine), and other local events)
- ④ Incineration of waste as an unavoidable part of agriculture, forestry, or fisheries (e.g., slash-and-burn).
- ⑤ Minor incineration of waste such as bonfires and other ordinary activities in daily life.

Even if these exceptions apply, it is necessary to be careful so as not to cause trouble to the surrounding residents. In addition, if there is a complaint that there is a problem in the living environment, etc., it will be subject to guidance.

Please refer to page 5 for more information on weeds (fallen leaves) and branches and leaves disposal method, and cooperate in their proper treatment and disposal.

Illegal dumping and outdoor garbage burning violations

The offender may be sentenced to imprisonment for up to 5 years or a fined up to 10 million yen, or both. Corporations may be fined up to 300 million yen.






